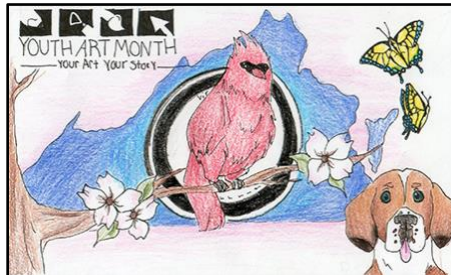

Skyline Middle School student has Youth Art Month flag design selected to represent Virginia 2019

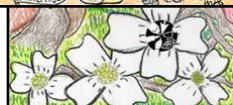
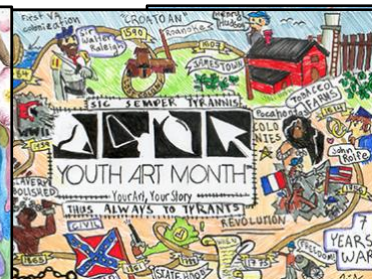

First through fourth place winners were selected for each level; elementary, middle and high school.

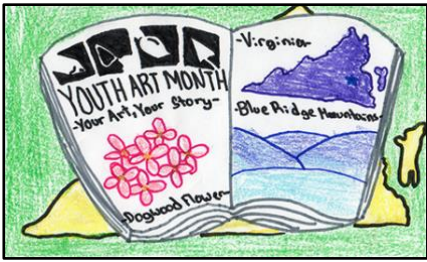
