Spend two nights in a house designed by a FLW apprentice. Tour homes at Polymath Park, Fallingwater, or Kentuck Knob. Savor dinner at Treetops restaurant, inspired by FLW. Enjoy a selection of restaurants in Uniontown. Experience the thrill of outdoor adventures on the Youghiogeny River. Hike trails to witness natural wonders.

Lodging:

Blum House, Polymath Park: This home designed by Wright apprentice Peter Berndston sleeps 6. Cost is \$250 each for 2 nights.

Hampton Inn, Uniontown, PA: A short drive from Fallingwater. About \$180 for 2 nights for up to 4 people. Classic hotel with complimentary breakfast, swimming pool and wifi. Uniontown offers dining and shopping.

Frank Lloyd Wright Tours:

\$30 for Fallingwater tour,
\$80 in-depth, \$140 brunch, and \$130 sunset tours;
\$25 for Kentuck Knob tour,
\$65 in-depth, \$12 woodland and sculpture garden walk;
\$24 for Polymath Park tour,
\$50 lunch tour, \$37 Wright & Wine, \$95 dinner tour.
