<b>4 Points</b>	Candidate has a strong history at the National Level: Appointed as the Southeastern Division Director, Served on several NAEA Committees or Awarded several Honors, Participated in the Southeastern Leadership Retreat, Presented numerous sessions at the National Conventions.
<b>3 Points</b>	Candidate has an emerging history at the National Level: Served on an NAEA Committee or Awarded NAEA Commendation, Participation in the Southeastern Leadership Retreat and Presented multiple sessions at NAEA Conventions.
<b>2 Points</b>	Candidate has a limited history at the National Level: Presented several sessions at NAEA Conventions

<b>5 Points</b>	Candidate has exceptional evidence of accomplishments: Chaired multiple committees for art curriculum, frameworks, content, standards, assessment and integration. Extensive leadership and mentorship.
<b>4 points</b>	Candidate has strong evidence of accomplishments: Committee participant in art curriculum, frameworks, content standards, assessment and integration. Mentors pre-service teachers.
<b>3 Additional Points</b>	Candidate has an ongoing history of personal art works exhibitions.
<b>2 Additional Points</b>	Candidate possesses active National Board Certification.

## Contributions to the Art Community

<b>3 points</b>	Candidate has exceptional evidence of contributions: Chaired on an arts commission or museum committee, received and directed a grant funding a public art exhibit. Acknowledged as an Arts Advocate.
<b>2 points</b>	Candidate has strong evidence of contributions: served on an arts commission or museum committee, received and directed a grant funding a public art exhibit. Volunteers as a museum docent.
<b>1 point</b>	Candidate has limited evidence of contributions: Volunteers as a docent, possess museum memberships and attends exhibits and forums concerning Arts Issues
<b>1/2 point</b>	Candidate has limited contributions: possess museum memberships and attends exhibits and forums concerning Arts Issues
